Dog Tags

Every Dog living inside City Limits is required to have a City Issued Dog License.

Dog Licenses will be provided only with proof of current Rabies Vaccinations. Now through the end of February dog licenses are only \$2. After the close of business on Feb. 28th, dog licenses purchased late will incur a fine of \$20 on top of the \$2 license. These Licenses satisfy State of Iowa Regulations.

Garbage Cans

Reminder to all citizens of Gilmore that Garbage Bins need to be near the curb and the opening of the bin facing the street and not placed too close to mailboxes, cars, etc. This makes it difficult for the truck to get to it, which may cause your trash not to be dumped or can cause accidental damage to vehicles, mailboxes, etc.
